The Law farm.

The Law farm just west of the Carter farm was cleared by John Law. He had 4 sons and 1 daughter. Levi lived in Aylmer. And William on the back of Law farm and Jim on the next place west and Andrew on the place east.

Jim Law and his family moved to Courtwright. William died on the place back.

Andrew Law died on the farm with his son Melvin lived and one daughter Loila married a man by the name of Law and died on the right.

Melvin Law had 3 daughters Mrs. ^(Glossie) George Carter, Mrs. Grace Brooks and Mrs. ^(John) Arthur Benner.

He lived several years in bed at George Carters before he died and Mrs Melvin Law broke her hip and was in bed there too before she died.

George Carter Farm

Before George Carter died he sold the back 100 acres to Mike Fabiam. George Carter died April 13th 1971 Mrs Carter then went to live among her 3 children. Mrs Wray Miller, Mrs Bill Haleback and Mack Carter. Mrs Carter sold the farm to Mack her only son. He went down to live where they did and rented the house ~~on~~ the west place to Steve Harris and on June 1971. Mack and his wife lived on the east place until the spring of 1974.

Then Steve Harris moved to Brownsville and Mack sold the east house to Bill Harris he other stepson and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres.

Mack's other stepson and he fixed some of the buildings and built 2 other big buildings and runs a very successful plastic business.

In the spring of 1977 Mack sold his west place and the rest of the east farm keeping 3 acres to Bill & Sutter in March 1st He built them a house on the 3 acres for themselves.
