AYLMER.—“She is the first one up in the morning,” said Mrs. Velma Pendreigh, assistant nurse at the ‘Coral Parsons’ Rest Haven in Aylmer.

Mrs. Pendreigh was referring to Mrs. Carrie Herbert, who celebrated her 100th birthday Sunday. “She gets up, dresses, makes her bed by herself and sometimes has to lay back down until everyone else gets up,” said Mrs. Pendreigh.

A native of Walsingham, Mrs. Herbert lived in the Mapleton

area for over 50 years. She has one son Wilfred Herbert of Kingsmill and a daughter, Mrs. Eva Cox of Tillsonburg.

She came to live at the Rest Haven four years ago, at the age of 96. “She lived on the farm until age 96,” said Mrs.

Parson, “and was still milking cows at 80.”

“She had a bad fall some time ago, breaking her arm but it wasn't long before she was up and around in her same old ways, keeping every one in stitches.”

GOOD SENSE OF HUMOR

Mrs. Herbert is known at the Rest Haven for an unusually sharp wit and a good sense of humor.

“All the laughs she had given us in the last four years we should have written down,” said Mrs. Parsons. “One time she got lost in the hallway, and when approached by the nurse, she said she couldn't find her ‘coop.’”

When asked what she would like to be able to do most of all, she said she would like to be able to do her own work for a change.

“If any one at the Haven gets sick,” said Mrs. Parsons, she is right there offering help. One time she told me to sit down and take it easy while she did the dishes.”

Mrs. Herbert still takes an interest in what's going on outside the home. “She is able to read the headlines in the newspaper,” said Mrs. Parsons. “When she sees something that interests her, she asks us to read it to her.”

Recently Mrs. Parsons told her that since the centennial birthday was coming up, she couldn't be called 99 much longer.

“Well,” said Mrs. Herbert, “you just go along and pop, you're there!”
