Their daughter Effie M. Currie then owned the property. She was born Feb. 18, 1884 and died Sept. 13, 1942. All of the above are buried in Shedden Cemetery.

The records are incomplete in the interval between 1942 and 1973 when Mary Vary and Dorothy Turner are listed as the owners.

This is a double house, 167 A being the North side and 167 B being the south side. 167 A was occupied by Mrs. Charles Holborn during the 2nd World War.

HISTORY

Records show that in 1893 this property was in the name of Charles Warwick. From information taken from Shedden Women's Institute Tweedsmuir History, Book I, Charles Warwick built a grist and saw mill here in 1895 and operated it for a number of years.

In 1900 when the P. M. Railway went through much of the property in that section of the village was bought and moved to make way for the railway right-of-way.

T. R. McMackon bought this mill and converted part of it into a berry box and basket factory. This was one of the thriving industries, employing about thirty men and women. A picture of the basket factory may be found in Volume 2, Book 1 of the Tweedsmuir History. The picture is thought to have been taken about 1909.

Sometime between 1930 and 1953 David Lyle owned the property - Dates unknown

The house presently on this property was originally situated between the two Railways, and on the east side of Union Road. The Francis family lived here because Catherine L. (Cass) (Francis) Wood was born there on November 14, 1904. This was told by Cass to Dora McArthur before Cass's death in 1984.

The house was moved from it's former location to it's present location in the early 1930's.

A series of tenants rented the house from the early 1930's onward.
