

and also a Mr Pugsley. June 21st 1891 the Sunday School was organized with Pastor C. W. King as superintendent, J. Chambers as secretary. The teachers were Mr L. Hyde, Mrs L. Hyde, Mrs Tibbitts, Mrs Boyer, and Miss Tedford.

In 1893 (June 16th) Mr A. Creasy a student of Woodstock spent the summer months with the Church and showed much interest with them in anticipation of erecting and procuring a better place to worship in. As the Horticultural Hall, was found not to be entirely satisfactory and convenient, therefore in the summer of 1893 they were convinced that a new church was necessary, and decided to have one erected at once. The contract was let to W. H. Goff + Davis and was finished by December 1893. The foundation was built and on Sept 11<sup>th</sup> 1893 the corner stones were laid one, by Rev A. J. Lowerby and the other by Samuel Lapcott. The rest of the building was soon completed with a baptistry and was dedicated. Rev George Mason preached the dedicatory sermon. So the twenty members first organized in Feb 13<sup>th</sup> 1887 were now settled in the new church with a nucleus of twenty seven members.

On Sept. 24<sup>th</sup> Rev G. Mason took charge of the pastorate. until Jan. 31st 1894.

On July 12 1895 Mr G. B Brown became an ordained minister and took charge of the church, and added many to the Church Roll.

The following ministers have since occupied the pulpit, Mr Palmer, Rev Mr Bridgeman, Rev. John M. White, Rev. Shaw, Rev. Carey, In 1897 Rev George Mason again took up the work. He was followed by W. Templeman, Mr Hartely Mr Hilts, Rev. U. E. Orton, of Colorado became the steady pastor until 1901. He had the parsonage remodeled and enclosed with white brick.

In May 1901 Rev W. J. H. Brown became pastor. In Jan 1902 Rev A. R. McDonald became pastor until Nov. 1903. He was followed by Mr L. S. Haverstock of Woodstock College. In Sept. 1904 Rev J. C. Dunlop and continued until 1912 when the church experienced much prosperity from his long and faithful ministry.

The Sunday school was re-organized in 1907 when Mr Dunlop took charge.

On Sept 15 1907 Harvey M. Woolley became the superintendent, and has been continuously to the present date.

In 1931 Rev J. H. Yelland became pastor and is the present pastor, being the longest pastorate on record.

The church is enjoying wonderful peace and spiritual prosperity.
