fully Agreed upon the first day of July.  
in the Year of our Lord 1852. between  
John Turner of the Town of Brantford in the County of  
Front Architect of the one part And the  
Provisional Municipal Council of the County of  
Elgin of the other part, as follow. that  
is to say, The said John Turner for himself his  
Heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby  
Covenant Promise and Agree to and with the  
said Provisional Municipal Council of the County of  
Elgin in Manner following that is to say that  
he the said John Turner shall and will  
with truly and faithfully either in person or by  
some Competent Person to be by him appointed  
and approved by the said Council inspect and  
superintend the Construction Erection and  
Completions of the Court House and Jail for the  
said County of Elgin according to the  
Plans and Specifications thereof by him the  
said John Turner made and adopted by the  
said Council, and Report or Cause to be  
Reported to the said Council or the Warden  
thereof as often as required, true Correct and  
faithful Estimates Statements and Accounts  
as the said Work progresses, of the Work done  
and the Sum or Sums required to be paid for the  
same, in Accordance with the Contract Entered  
into between the Contractor for the building  
of the said Buildings, and the said  
Council, and that he will prevent or Cause  
to be prevented any unjust Excitation or  
Demand being made from or upon the said  
Council during the progress of the said Work  
by the said Contractor, but shall see or Cause  
to be seen that the said Buildings are

same, in reference to the Contract for the  
Construction Erection and Completion of the  
~~same~~ thereof as may be necessary to guide the  
said Council in carrying out on its part  
the said Contract, and the said Provisional  
Municipal Council of the County of Brant  
in Payment and Consideration of the Covenants  
and Services aforesaid doth hereby Covenant  
Promise and Agree to and with the said John  
Turner his heirs Executors and Administrators  
that there shall be well truly and faithfully  
paid to him the said John Turner for every  
Visit and Attendance he shall give as aforesaid  
the Sum of Four Pounds of lawful Money  
of Canada and for the daily Attendance  
and inspection either by himself or some competent  
Person by him to be appointed and approved of  
as aforesaid, the Sum of Seven Shillings and  
Six pence of like lawful Money. And  
for the due Performance of these Presents  
the

the said parties do hereby bind themselves  
and their respective representatives each unto  
the other in the Sum or Penalty of Five  
hundred Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain
