

HISTORY

This house was built in 1960 by Stanley G. & Cora (Mifflin) Miller, and the contractor was Jack Robinson, Iona Station. It was originally a 2 bedroom ranch, with white siding with a 1 car garage.

Following the deaths of Mrs. Miller in1966 and prior to Mr. Miller's in 1970, the property was purchased by Carl and Kay (Firby) Chamberlain. They had the well drilled in the front yard. They and their family lived here until moving to 127 Union Rd. in 1976.

The house on this property was built in 1922 and is the only red brick house in the village of Shedden. Dan Hamilton was the architect. The cement blocks in the foundation were made by Elgin & Lou Biddle of Lawrence Station. The bricks probably came from the McGibbon Brick Yard on # 3 Highway and the lumber from Ike Jackson's Lumber yard. Woodwork in the house was from a walnut tree on Dan Hamilton's farm. It was a fallen tree and they walked over it to get across the creek. Someone mentioned to Dan one day that he should use that old tree as he cut his axe into it and stated it was walnut - and thus he did.

When the house was purchased by the Palmers, they rented it to the Bank Managers until they moved to it from their home at the store in 1948.


