In 1877 with a population of 800 inverporation of the village was applied for and granted.

The Village of Springfield was Incorporated in June, 1877.

The first meeting of the Members of the first Municipal Council of the newly Incorporated Municipality of the Village of Springfield, assembled at John Dyne's hotel, at 11 oc'clock, A. M. on January, 21st, 1878.
