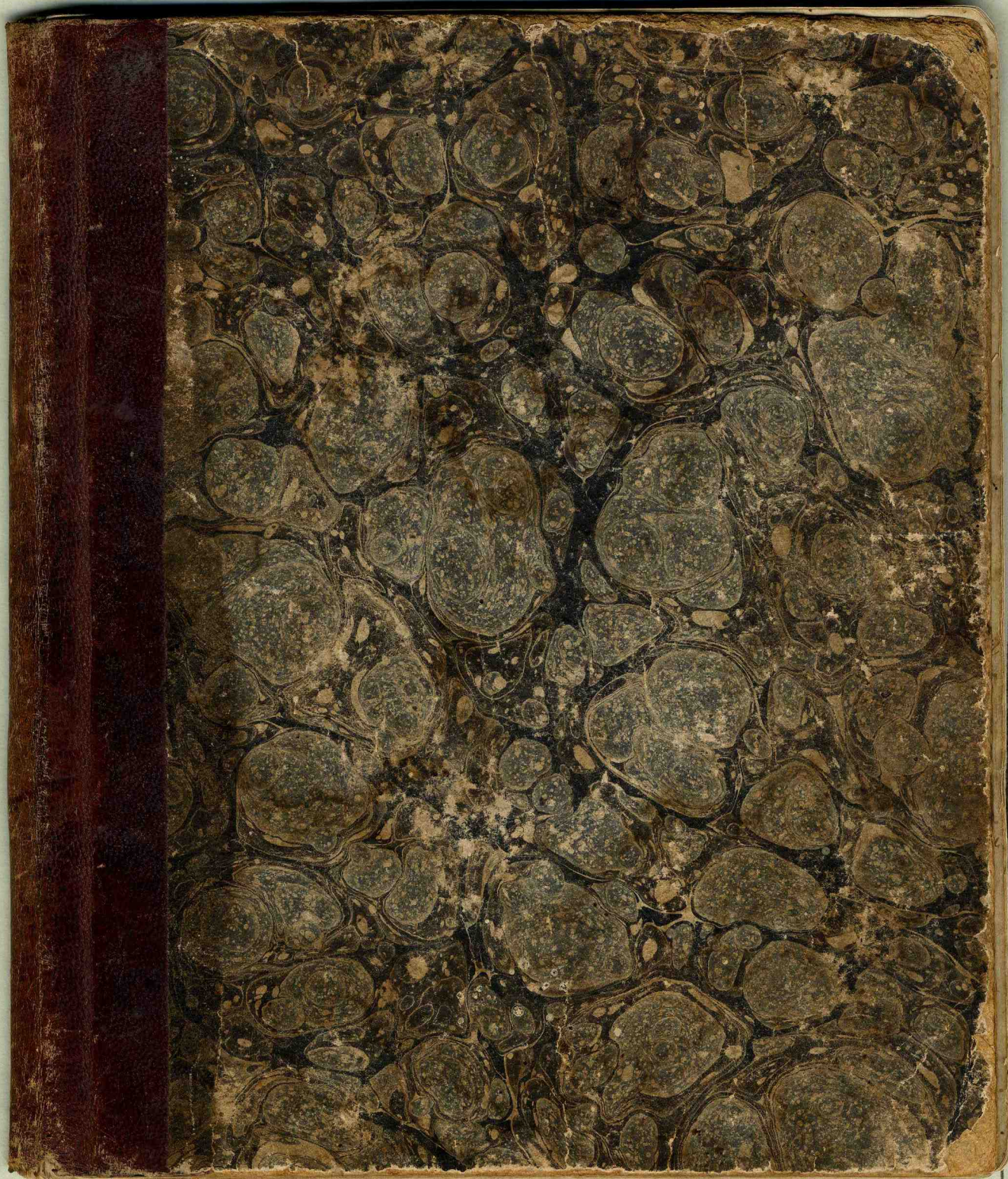

Bylaw No. 9

It is hereby enacted by the Trustees of school section No. two in Norwich that ~~the~~ bylaw No. six be repealed.

It is further enacted that the engraved seal attached to these bylaws shall be the seal of this corporation.

Bylaw No. 10

It is hereby enacted by the Trustees of school section No. two in Norwich that Pupils ^{years of age} ~~aged~~ sixteen shall not be allowed to come from other school sections to ^{attend} this school.

Passed 17th January 1854

By-law No. 11

It is hereby enacted by the Trustees of School Section No 2. that the sum of fifty four pounds be levied and assessed on the rateable property of this section for the purpose of paying the Teachers Salary for the current year.

It is further enacted that the Township Clerk be authorized to make the said assessment and that the sum of seven shillings and six pence be allowed the said Clerk for ^{his} said work.

It is further enacted that George H. Moore be ^{authorized} appointed to collect the said sum of fifty four pounds and that the sum of five per cent be allowed said collector for all moneys collected by him.

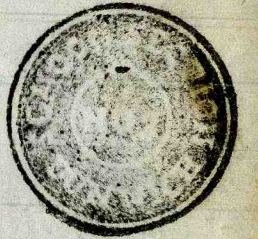


By-Law No 12

By-Law No 13

It is hereby enacted by the board of Trustees of School Section No. 2. that the sum of fifty five pounds, say be raised by assessment on the rateable property of this school section, for the purpose of paying the balance of the Teachers Salary and the incidental expenses of the school for the current year. and it is further enacted
