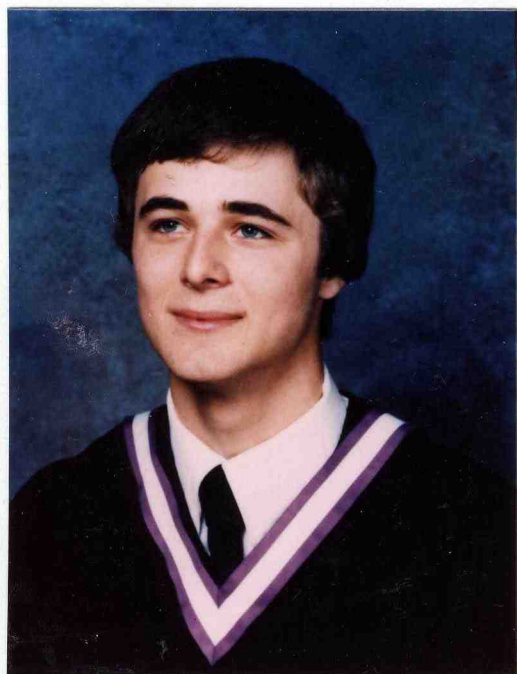

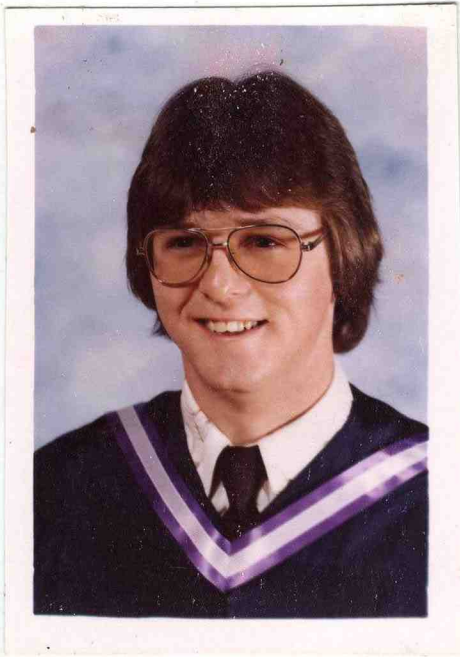

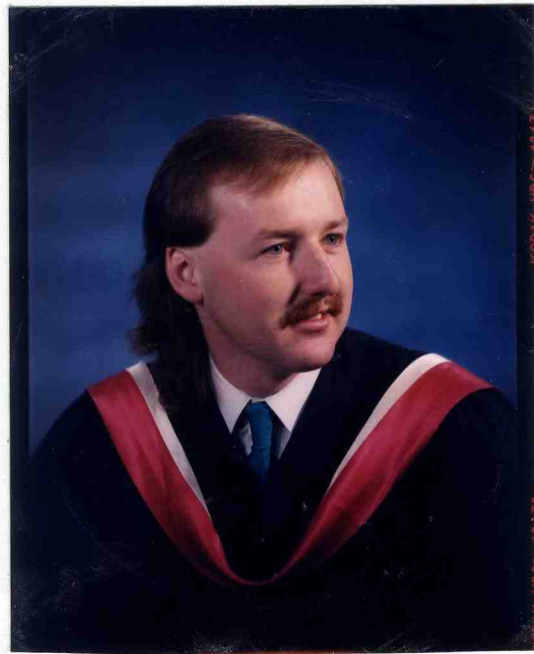
These two young people are the son and daughter of Jim and Leta West of R. R. 3, Dutton. Both attended West Elgin Secondary School.

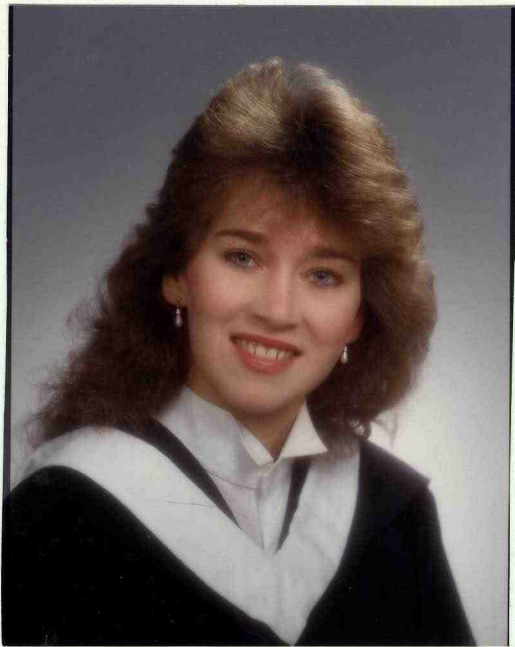

Joan presently works at Hoodingford Lodge, Woodstock, as the Recreation Administrator for the 260 bed seniors home.

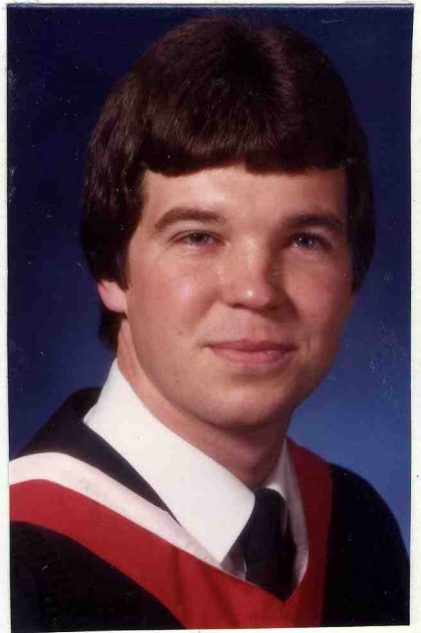
Joan has one daughter, Karla.

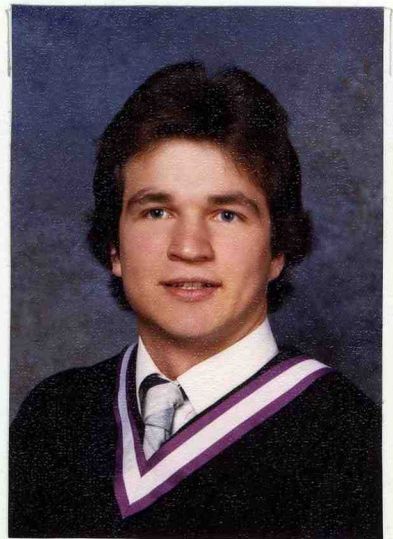
