The two Tweedsmuir History Books were on display at the Annual Meeting of the Wallacetown Women's Institute on Wed. April 3rd 1980.

The first Tweedsmuir History to be compiled, told of the History of Wallacetown and the Talbot Settlement from 1800 - 1960. This book was microfilmed in 1979 at Western University London. Mr. E. Wells of the Elgin County Library St. Thomas, very kindly took the book to London for us. There was no charge for any of the work.

There were 3 films made, one for the St. Thomas Library, one for Hutton Library and one for the Wallacetown Women's Institute. The negative was to be kept in the vault at Western University.

During the year several adults and children had the use of the Tweedsmuir Histories, taking material from them for essays and reports of the history of the Community.
