INTRODUCTION

1993 - 1994 - 1995

In the following pages I have tried to trace the owners of some of the older farms in the township of Dunwich, back to the time of Colonel Talbot. I have visited the Registry Office in St. Thomas, Ontario. It is impossible to determine from the records their, the year in which these homes were built on the farms. In the early years there were smaller log or farm houses, many of these homes appear to have some of the original beams. THE MCKILLOP FARM
Lot Ten, Concession Six,
Dunwich Township, Elgin County, Ontario

In 1850, Donald McKillop and his brother Archibald immigrated to Canada from Scotland, staying with friends in Southwold Township. In 1853, Donald's adult son Donald moved to a cousin's in Dunwich Township. In 1854, he was granted, from the Crown, a tract of land which is now Lot ten, Concession six, Clay Street West. Donald married Christine McArthur, and they built a log house on the property. Donald and his wife had nine children. In 1875, the present house was built with all the building material coming from the farm, except the bricks. After Donald's death in 1904, his son Daniel Donald took over the farming operation. Daniel married Annie McMurchy and they had two children, John and Margaret Jean. After Daniel's death in 1949, John continued the operation. John married Margaret Bancroft and they have two children, Mary Agnes and Daniel John.

The farming operation has changed over the years, from mixed, to dairy, and the present cow-calf. Daniel J. married Janet Jones, and they have four children, Matthew John, Donna Janet, Mark Daniel, and Adam Lyle. These children are the sixth generation of McKillops since they immigrated from Scotland. John McKillop is the present owner of Lot ten Concession six, and trusts that his son and grand-children will continue the farming operation.
