and Eleanor B Smith on Sept 13<sup>th</sup> 1955, to Oliver & Viola  
Brooker on March 6<sup>th</sup> 1958. April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1961 to Morley and Mary  
Griffin, Oct 22<sup>nd</sup> 1971 Alexander and Marie Horkey, June 23<sup>rd</sup>

Small. 1996 Purchased Douglas & Beverly Small are the current owners.

March 22, 1821

Patent from the Crown to Colonel Thomas Talbot

July 27, 1823

Colonel Talbot deeded one half of the property to William Clay

January 12, 1826

Colonel Talbot deeded the other half of the property to Samuel Tobyne

April 17, 1827

Samuel Tobyne deeded his property to James Tobyne

June 12, 1852

James Tobyne deeded his property to Thomas McColl

June 12, 1852

William Clay deeded his property to Thomas McColl

The two properties then became one property.

This property then remained in the McColl family for many years. The property was passed on through the family. I could not find some of the deeds.

March 19, 1906

Duncan McColl conveyed to Malcolm McColl

November 26, 1946

Margaret McColl conveyed to Hugh Hergus McColl and Margaret McColl.

December 13, 1951

Margaret McColl and Hugh Fergus McColl conveyed to Margaret McColl, Hugh Fergus McColl and Annie McColl

November 30, 1973

Annie McColl (aka MacColl) conveyed to Merle Harris and John Evans, Jr.

June 16, 1977

Merle Harris and John Evans, Jr. conveyed to Merle Harris

May 30, 1978

Merle Harris conveyed to Larry Small.

At a later date, the property was then put into both Larry Small and Kathy Small's names.
