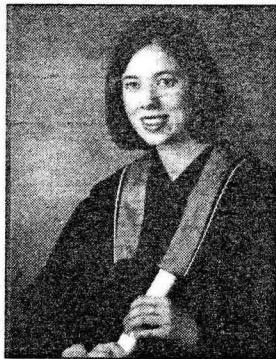

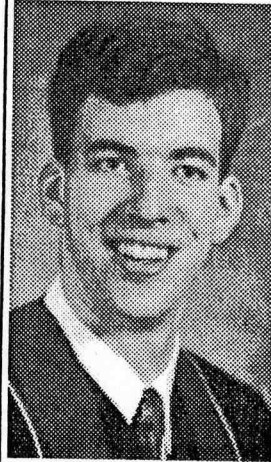


LAURA LACKEY

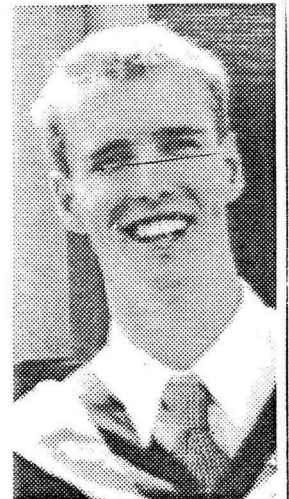

The wedding took place Saturday, June 23rd, 2001, at Holy Angels Roman Catholic Church, St. Thomas, with Father Nevett officiating.

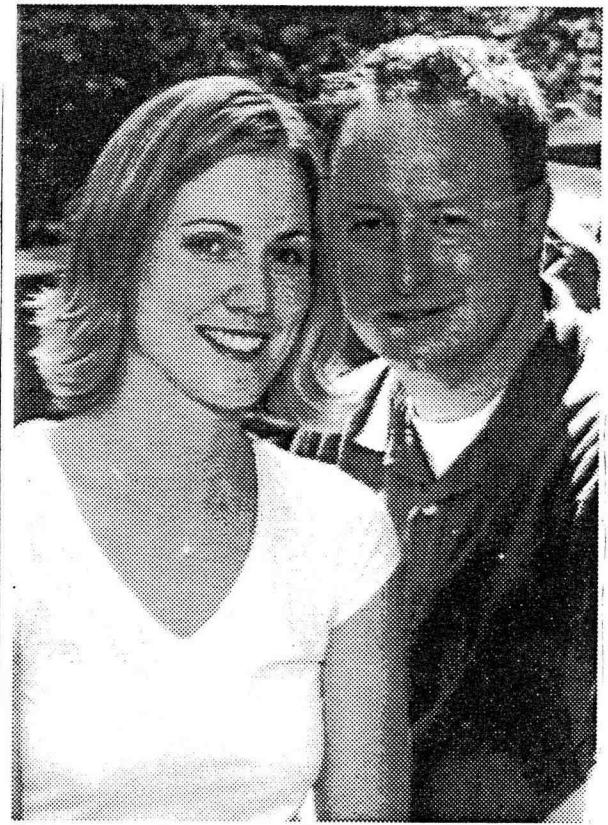

Lisa and Brian thank their families and friends for the love and support that made their day so special.

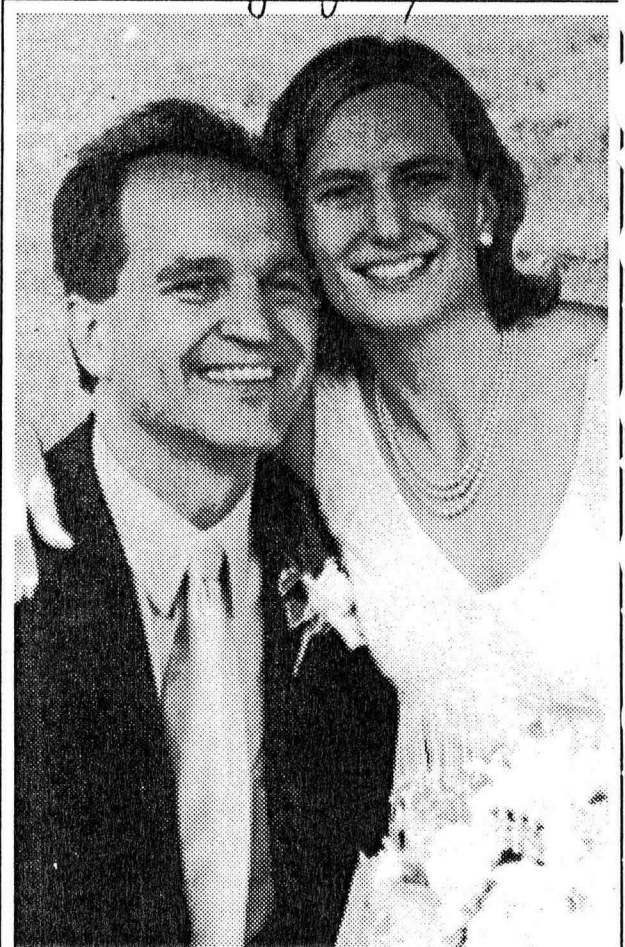


Johnson - Hoogenboom
