50th anniversary celebrated by skating club

Celebrating its 50th anniversary, the West Elgin Skating Club is hosting a carnival that looks back on its 50 years through performances that look at the music and style of the past 50 years.

"Every year, we say the carnival is for them (the current skaters). Maybe selfishly this year, this carnival is for all of us who have had skates on," said Sharon Nielson, the club's carnival chairperson.

While some of the board and current coaches are past members of the club, others are coming back to attend the event and a special dinner being held between the two performances.

"Fifty years on the ice was not built without volunteers. It has taken a lot of people over the years," said Nielson.

The members have been rehearsing since January but plans for the event have been in the works since last year.

"Everyone is excited. We've limited the number of tickets and we've sold just over half," said Nielson, recommending people get tickets ahead from club members to avoid disappointment if they are sold out at the door this year.

With 130 skaters this year, Nielson said the club has always managed to maintain a strong membership.

"You're either a hockey family or a figure skating family," she said of the people living in the area.

The club started in 1954 but its first carnival may not have been until 1955. It's why the club's "Retro Mania" event celebrates 50 years on the ice.

Fifty years since it started, Nielson said they're having a lot of fun looking back.

"Probably my most fun decade to get ready was for the hippies," she said, adding putting a number together with children in poodle skirts was a lot of fun too.

"We enjoyed trying to get those numbers together," she said.

One of the highlights for this year's celebration comes with guest skater Jeffrey Buttle.

The Barrie skater is a Canadian silver and bronze medalist and the 2004 Four Continents Champion. In 2002 and this year, he was a bronze medalist in the Canadian Nationals and took silver in 2003.

The December 2002 issue of International Figure Skating magazine named Buttle as one of the top 10 most beautiful people in skating.

"He's a pretty awesome guy and this is a big deal for us," said Nielson. "For him to even consider coming to West Lorne, we're thrilled."

She said he's a positive role model, especially for the boys in the club.

"We have a few male skaters we want to encourage," said Nielson, adding Buttle's presence will be an encouragement to all the members through his sportsmanship and own positive attitudes.

The event takes place March 6 with afternoon and evening performances.
