Women's group seeks new recruits

Area members of the Women's Institute meet in Thorndale today.

From leading the charge to have milk pasteurized to London's own contribution that saw fog lights installed on school buses, the Federated Women's Institutes of Canada have put their unique stamp on life in rural communities.

Today, London Area Women's Institute members will hold their 92nd annual convention at the Thorndale Community Centre.

And if member Debbie Bauer has her way, one theme will be the need to start touting those achievements.

As the group — founded in 1897 — sees its membership plummet, Bauer says the need for the Women's Institute has never been greater.

"We've got to recruit young, new members, or we're done," says Bauer, incoming first vice-president for London area. "But we're our own worst enemy because we just quietly go about our work and few people know the impact we've made on (government) decision-making over the years."

Among those achievements from a group founded to give rural women a voice:

▶ War work, under the umbrella of the Red Cross, offering socks, scarves, chocolates and other items to soldiers.

- ► Centre white lines on all provincial highways.
- Music programs for schools.
- ► Grading of poultry for sale.
- Stop signs at railway crossings.
- Wrapping of bread.
- ► Mandatory stopping for school buses.

"What people don't realize is Women's Institute once had a seat at the table of government for all rural decisions," says Bauer.

The decline of the family farm, a drop in volunteerism and the need for many women to work off the farm have contributed to the membership's decline.

At 53, Bauer is one of the group's younger members. But she hopes to recruit more women, noting "the isolation of women, particularly in rural areas, continues to this day."

About 170 are expected at the Thorndale convention, taking in the counties of Middlesex, Elgin, Perth, Huron and Oxford.

Bauer says the institute's newest project involves the "Go-go grannies" — grandmothers of Africa featured at this year's International Aids Conference in Toronto, who are raising their grandchildren because their children have died of AIDS.

"Many can't even afford the coffins to bury their kids and they're raising their grandkids."
