Terrace Lodge: the heart of caring and sharing.

Terrace Lodge Long Term Care Home is a municipal, not-for-profit facility situated on the edge of Aylmer in the Township of Malahide, Elgin County. Built in 1977 at a time when many residents were high functioning and driving their own vehicles and going on regular outings.

Over time it has become home to one hundred residents requiring 24-hour care and support, including specialized care for those with dementia.

The Home is also the site of many community services for older adults, including day programs and recreational swimming.

The redevelopment process is starting


The redevelopment of Terrace Lodge will be completed over three years:

- ✓ **Phase 1** - A state-of-the-art addition will be constructed. It will connect with the existing home and provide enhanced comfort, privacy, safety and social spaces for our residents, families and visitors.
- ✓ **Phase 2** - The north wing of the existing home will be fully renovated to create lovely dining rooms, bedrooms and recreational spaces. Kitchen renovations will commence.
- ✓ **Phase 3** - The south wing of the existing home will be renovated; kitchen upgrades will be completed and main floor spaces will be refreshed and updated.

When completed, there will be **4 beautiful living areas**, each accommodating 25 residents. One of these areas will be designed specifically for our residents with dementia.



