

Notice of Project: St. George Street Reconstruction

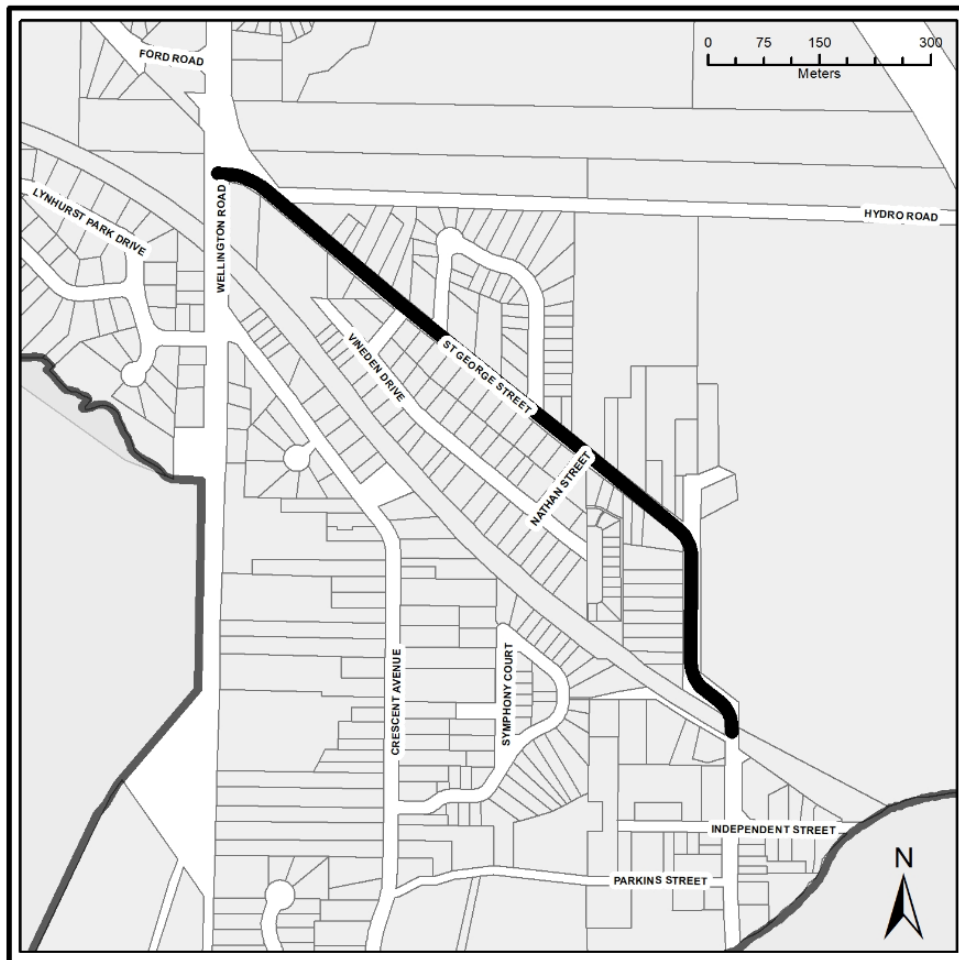

Dear Property Owner/Resident/Merchant,

The County of Elgin in partnership with the Municipality of Central Elgin are planning to reconstruct St. George Street in your area to replace aging infrastructure that has exceeded its expected lifecycle. This letter provides you with information about the project, includes a link to the project website (<https://www.elgincounty.ca/st-george-street-reconstruction/>) and a survey to provide us with feedback about your road.

Project Location

Proposed Work Details

- Storm sewer replacement
- Sidewalk replacement
- New asphalt surface replacement
- Tree removals (where required) and replacement
- Concrete curb replacement

Proposed Project Timeline

- Pre-Construction Investigation: February 2021 – June 2021
- Pre-Construction Public Information Centre: Fall 2021*
- Design Finalization: Fall 2021*
- Construction Start: Spring 2022*
- Estimated Completion: Fall 2022* (*with some minor cleanup work in Spring 2023*)

* Please note that the timelines are approximate and will vary depending on weather and other factors.



Pre-Construction Investigation

In the coming months, County/Municipality staff and consultants will be on your road investigating issues to support design work for the project. This may involve drilling holes, assessing trees, videotaping the streetscape, and testing in some homes to locate sewer connections. You may also see lines painted on the road and yard; this is how we identify existing underground pipes and infrastructure.

Pre-Construction Survey

As part of our investigation, we would appreciate you taking the time to fill out the attached questionnaire to share any feedback you might have related to flooding, traffic or any other neighbourhood considerations. Completed surveys can be returned to the County using the enclosed self-addressed stamped envelope.

Transportation Impacts

The County is currently evaluating how pedestrians, motorists, and cyclists could be impacted by this project. More information will be available at a future Public Information Centre.
