Despite this past week's mixed weather, Clearwater Structures was able to get the Meeks Bridge Replacement Project started, and the Project Team also wishes to advise you that the following works were completed:

- Installed all required detour and road closed signage;
- Removed guiderails;
- Installed silt fence;
- Installed access platforms;
- Established layout for the new bridge substructure; and,
- Completed full depth road approach asphalt removals

Crews will be back onsite tomorrow (*May 1, 2021*) to:

- Advance additional geotechnical boreholes

Next week's anticipated work activities (weather permitting) will include the following:

- Priestly Demolition Inc. will be demolishing the existing bridge structure.
